MVS is available to perform the following procedures:

Orthopedic Surgery

Stifle

- Cranial cruciate ligament injury treatment with TPLO or lateral fabellotibial suture repair
- Patellar luxation correction

Hip

- Femoral head & neck ostectomy

Shoulder

- Osteochondritis Dissecans (OCD) removal

Elbow

- Fragmented Medial Coronoid Process (FMCP or FCP) or Ununited Anconeal Process (UAP) excision

Fracture or luxation repair

Soft Tissue Surgery

Abdominal

- Gastrointestinal: foreign body retrieval, full-thickness intestinal biopsies, mass removal, pyloroplasty, subtotal colectomy in cats

- Hepatobiliary: cholecystectomy, biliary diversion, liver biopsy or mass removal

- Urinary: cystotomy, urinary bladder repair, nephrectomy

- Diaphragmatic hernia or peritoneopericardial hernia repair

Airway

- Brachycephalic airway: stenotic nares & soft palate correction

- Laryngeal paralysis: arytenoid lateralization

Thoracic

- Lung lobectomy or partial lobectomy, pericardectomy, PDA occlusion, PRAA correction

Oncologic

- Digit or limb amputation, mastectomy, mass excision, bone or lymph node biopsy

Rear end

- Lower urinary tract: perineal urethrostomy in cats, scrotal urethrostomy in dogs, urethral trauma management

- Perineal: anal saccullectomy, perineal hernia repair, rectal mass excision, vulvoplasty

While many procedures can be performed on an out-patient basis, overnight hospitalization will sometimes be required. Patients with significant concurrent medical conditions or traumatic injuries will require additional diagnostics and postoperative care. Referral to a hospital providing 24 hour specialty care is ideal in many cases.
